

Fees

Childcare is a ministry supplemented by members and regular attenders of The Church at Arrowhead through faithful tithing. The bible study fee includes child care for the semester.

Availability and Reservations

Childcare availability will be based on the size of the room, the number of childcare workers and the ages of the children.

Our primary goal is to provide a SAFE environment; we strive to maintain the proper balance of worker to child ratios at all times.

hmccarty@tcaa.com. If child care is full a waiting list will be established. Reservations will be required each semester; fall reservations will carry to spring.

Tips for Dealing with Separation Anxiety

- Relax. Your child senses your stress.
- Avoid rushing to church. At the classroom door, remind your child you will be back soon.
- Leave immediately.
- Please do not come back to the classroom to “check on” your child.
- Talk positively about church.
- Staying home and away from church will not help this problem. With consistent attendance and natural development this phase will end.

Activities and Schedule

Child care time is largely free play. Additional activities may include coloring, crafts, both biblical and seasonal, outside play (weather permitting) or movies, both Christian and secular.

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General Information

Childcare is available for Women's Ministry and iMom's for children ages birth through 5 years old. Childcare hours are 9:15 am to 11:45 am. *Please pick up your child promptly at the end of class.*

Employed, home-based daycare providers will not be eligible to leave the children in their charge in paid childcare. Only children in the care of a parent or grandparent are eligible for childcare.

Room assignments are based on age groupings, individual child development and space availability. For the health and safety of your child, only children of appropriate age will be allowed in the classroom. *Please DO NOT move your child to a different room, or request room changes.*

Creating A Positive Atmosphere For Your Child

Please stop at the table inside the main door. Make your child a name tag and label your child's belongings (diaper bag, bottle and/or cup). Please provide a separate bag for children in different rooms.

Please do not enter the classroom unless invited to do so by the teacher.

<p>Toilet Training</p> <p>Children being toilet trained should have a change of clothing in a labeled bag. Pull-ups are recommended until the child is fully toilet trained.</p>
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Health Policies

In order to ensure the safety and health of all children and workers, please do not bring your child if he/she has had any of the following symptoms within the past 24 hours:

- Diarrhea
- Vomiting
- Fever
- Rash
- Open Sores
- Hives
- Runny Nose (except clear)

No medication will be given to any child in the Preschool under any circumstance.

Parents should report any food or environmental allergies to the child care director. **All areas of childcare are peanut-free zones.** Please do not send special snacks to class without the directors prior approval.

Snacks and Toys

A small snack will be provided during regular Bible Studies and Worship Services. Meals will not be served in the classroom.

Please leave all toys at home. This avoids any problems with sharing, participation or lost possessions. A small security item is acceptable for infants.

Behavior Concerns

If a discipline problem occurs, or if a child is unusually upset, the child will be removed from the situation and redirected in another way to help the child regain a positive focus. The teacher/childcare coordinator will notify the parent privately if behavior continues to be disruptive or if the child remains unsettled.
